Cascade Clamps - Cascade Manufacturing Company was founded in Portland, Oregon in the year 1943. They started out as a small machine shop at first employing four people. Sales for their initial year of operation amounted to about \$60,000. The very first recorded sales revenues involved the assembly and machining of stainless-steel pipe fittings, valves and other parts. Throughout five years of operation, the business had expanded to forty staff and their yearly sales volume had increased to 330 thousand dollars. Nowadays, Cascade is one of the top global manufacturers within the material handling trade.

Design and manufacturing of the company's first hydraulic cylinder allowed this young business to aggressively pursue new business possibilities. Throughout the final 60 years, the business of material handling has grown into a really complex field with Cascade proudly playing a part in its improvement. Cascade at the moment continues to develop as the leader provider of forklift attachments and different related items. The company feels confident in their potential in order to continue to lead the way in the business by understanding client's needs in the future and remaining competitive within the global market.

In the 1950's, Cascade began designing, making and selling hydraulic accessories. Construction was finished in the year 1956 on a new office so as to house all of the plant and office operations in Portland, Oregon at the company's current center of operations. Subsequent to fifteen years of business, total staff reached a hundred and eighty staff and sales had reached almost 2.3 million dollars.

In the year 1959 in Springfield, Ohio the next production facility was built. 1960 marked Cascade's initial transfer into the global world of the material handling industry when the company established interest in the Netherlands, England, and Australia.

In 1964, the business changed its name to the Cascade Corporation. Then in the year 1965, the company went public with a preliminary offering of 200,000 shares of common stock. Since then the company has expanded its manufacturing facilities throughout the continental USA to the locations Warner Robins Georgia to go along with its already present plants in Springfield, Ohio and Portland, Oregon. Cascade products are manufactured worldwide because of a lot of subsidiary operations. In the year 1944, a brand new facility was accomplished in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European control center. This plant is built to be the ultimate customer support centre.

Cascade further expanded their product base in 1996 and 1997 subsequent to acquiring five companies, which included the Kenhar Corporation, the worldwide best in blades.
