Forklift Seats - A seat is a strong, strong surface to be seated, usually raised above floor level. Usually used by one individual, most seats are on the support of four legs, although several could be in a triangular shape using just three legs. A stool is a kind of seat which does not have a back or any arm rests. A seat which has folding action and an inclining footrest is called a recliner, whereas a seat together with arms only is considered an arm seat. When a seat has connected wheels, it could be called a wheelseat and if the seat is hung from above, it is called a swing. A permanently connected seat in a train or a theatre is known as a seat or airline seat, yet when riding; it is a saddle as in bicycle saddle. A car seat is the type used within cars and an infant car seat will be a kind of seat particularly designed for little children.

The design of the seat could vary somewhat significantly in order to accommodate several requirements and aesthetic tastes. As an example, designs can be decorated with drilled openings, could consist of low backs or gaps for ventilation or be made of porous materials. The seat back could be designed as an included headrest by means of extending the height over the occupant's head. Seats may be made together with an attached, built in footrest or come with a separate matching ottoman. An ottoman is a short stool that is designed to be used as a movable footrest. Sometimes the ottoman can be connected to a glider chair with swing arms, permitting the ottoman to rock back and forth together with the glider similar to a rocking chair together with a built-in footrest.

Covers for seats are temporary fabric covers providing protections against wear or to offer better aesthetics. Currently presented there are a large variety of seat covers from leather to neoprene. More formal materials could be rented for occasions such as weddings to increase the decoration. Various seat covers have decorative seat ties or bows attached to be tied at the rear of the seat in a bow or decorative knot. Some people utilize customized clear plastic furniture covers to protect their costly seats and sofas.

Seat pads are cushions designed for seats, often decorative; they can likewise be utilized in vehicles to be able to add to the drivers' height. Orthopaedic backrests provide support for the back, usually in lower spine or lumbar region. A few manufacturers have their seat pad designs patented and are recognized by certain medical organizations.
